Cantilena and Bella Voce parents are cordially invited to shop at our Uniform Sale on September 29th. The shopping will be in the downstairs foyer area beginning at 4:00 pm. Make your donations September 15th and 22nd in the same location. Kakis, ballet slippers and white sneakers of all sizes are needed! All kakis will be sold for \$10.00 and sneakers will be priced at \$5.00. Ballet slippers will be priced according to quality. Donations to the choir are gladly accepted or a small portion will be donated back to the CGC and the remaining amount will be applied as a tuition discount. Please be reminded that all pants need to be flat front. The girls will be required to wear them beginning in October for casual performances. Please safety pin an index card with your name, phone number and your daughter's name on the pants. Shoes should be placed in a Ziploc bag with an index card containing the same information.

Concert Choir reminder: Your wardrobe items have change to black slacks and mostly black shoes for informal performances. At the uniform sale only the ballet slippers and low black heels are items you could use for performances.

If your daughter has outgrown her periwinkle Cantilena shirt, please consider donating it back to the choir.
