Tuesday, May 6th, Choir Share

Permission slips from the choir for this event are being sent home tonight. If you did not receive one when you picked up High Notes please see the choir rehearsal Desk.

Novellina and Cantilena members are meeting in the Chattanooga Room located on the UTC campus in the UC building. *Bella Voce* members will meet in the lobby outside the auditorium. The choir has been told that representatives will be directing members where they need to go.

Novellina: Please arrive at 11:15 to warm up by 11:45. The performance will end between 12:30 and 12:45. Please wear a blue-colored T-shirt and jeans.

Cantilena: Please arrive at 10:30 to warm up by 10:45. The performance will be over between 12:30 and 12:45. Please wear your CGC periwinkle T-shirt, jeans and predominately white tennis shoes.

Bella Voce: Please arrive at 9:00 to warm up by 9:15. The performance will be over between 10:45 and 11:00. For uniformity please wear your CGC red T-shirt, jeans and predominately white tennis shoes.

SECKE Choir Share – Directions From 4th St.-

Turn toward UTC at the arena (Mable St.); there is a stop light at Mable and 4th. Pass the gym and turn right onto the street between the gym and the University Center. There is a circular drive in which to drop off your daughters.

After entering the building, *Novellina* and *Cantilena* should follow the signs or directions of volunteers to the Chattanooga room, which is to the right at the top of the stairs. *Bella Voce* will go left at the top of the stairs and gather in the lobby. Their warm-up will be on the stage of the auditorium.

Call time is 4:30pm (Wardrobe Check)

Please arrive fully dressed if you have received your dress. *The choir understands that not everyone will be able to arrive at 4:30 due to school commitments.* The choir also understands that not everyone will be able to arrive in standard concert attire. If you can not arrive fully dressed, please bring your black dress, shoes, and stockings (if you are Novolina your white shirt, shoes, white socks and skirts) and plan to dress at the church.

Wardrobe check will take place in the hallway where the rehearsal desk normally sits. After check-in, please go to your rehearsal rooms for attendance. All choirs will move from their normal rehearsal room to the sanctuary of the church at 4:50 p.m.

Dress rehearsal will begin at 5:00 p.m. The intent is to end dress rehearsal at 7:00 p.m. Depending on the progress of the rehearsal, it may continue until 7:30 p.m. The choir and generous volunteers are supplying bottled water and a snack for the dress rehearsal. The girls will have a chance to snack, drink water, and use the restroom.
